** Uniform Fitting:

Things to know about uniform fitting -

- Uniform fitting is "come and go" anytime during the given time frame. They do not have to stay the entire time. However, the earlier they arrive the better chance of finding the best fit for the uniform. They are free to go when they are done until rehearsal in the afternoon at 1:30 PM.
- You can either pay your band fees online at the REVTRAK store or with cash or check.

- They will be fitted for their band shorts, band shirt, and shoes as well as their uniform
 - o Freshmen need shorts, shirt, and shoes.
 - Sophomores through seniors only need the shirt UNLESS they can not find their band shorts and shoes OR need new shorts and shoes.
 - We will order shirts, shoes, and shorts once we have the orders in and we will pass those out when they arrive.
 - Students will use the Marching Band Uniform that they are fitted in.
 - Showing up earlier for this is better than showing up later.

Other details to note:

- Attendance is of the utmost importance. All absences must be excused by Mr. Fisher. Please contact Mr. Fisher if there may be an absence.
- For students who work, please plan carefully as missing rehearsals and performances for work is not excused.
- If you have recieved communication about UIL Physical Forms and Online Athletic Department Forms, please make sure you get all of that taken care of prior to Monday, July 29th.
- Families and students who have students in band as well as drill team, tennis, football, and volleyball, you should have received an email stating when and where you will be and your before school Summer events. I have been in contact with Coach Cochran, Coach Dimsdale, Coach Namanny, and Mrs. Pierce about how to share students during the Summer. If you did not receive this communication, and you have a student participating in these activities, please let me know.
- You will need your instrument, flip folder, and lyre for the first rehearsal and every rehearsal/performance through marching season.
 - Every student has a cubby assigned.
 - School owned instruments have been assigned and are in the student's cubby at the High School Band Hall.
- Wear Summer/Humid weather appropriate clothes to Summer Band and bring a water bottle. If participating in dress up days, make sure it is Summer Weather/Humid Weather appropriate.
- You must still abide by the student dress code concerning piercings and attire. If you have hair that will fall in your face causing problems with our "attention" maneuvers, please wear a hair tie or a ball cap so your hair can stay pulled back and won't disturb your face while marching.
- Please drop your student off either at the student parking lot or at the bus line and pick them up at the student parking lot so we do not cause traffic congestion at the back of the school. We have many events happening at Lindale High School over the next few weeks and we want to keep that area as uncongested as possible.
- When your student arrives to the band hall, all they need to do is find their name tag in their seat.
